Dr. Noshir Mehta is Associate Dean for International Relations, Professor and Chairman of the Department of General Dentistry as well as Director of the Craniofacial Pain Center at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine.

Dr. Mehta received his certificate and an M.S. degree in Periodontics in 1973 and his DMD in 1977 at Tufts.

Dr. Mehta has treated TMJ patients for the past 30 years and heads a multidisciplinary team treating approximately 2500 new patients with head, face, neck pain and dental sleep disorders.

In the past 20 years the center has also developed a large clinical research presence through the largest postgraduate and MS degree program in the US and is the first postgraduate program using innovation to offer a Distance Dental Education MS degree in TMD worldwide.

Dr. Mehta is a Diplomat of the American Board of Orofacial Pain and a Fellow in numerous academies.

He is senior editor of a major textbook in head, neck and face pain, has contributed chapters in multiple pain textbooks and published extensively in peer reviewed journals.

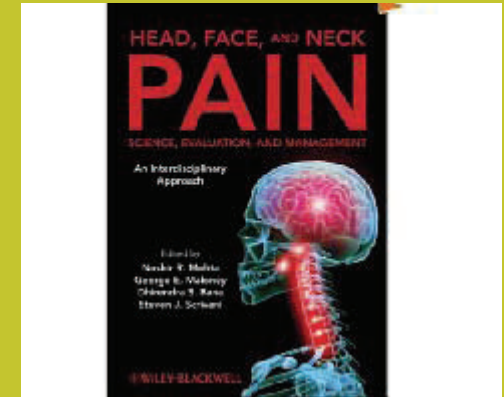
He is currently Editor in Chief of Dentistry India and serves on the editorial board of several professional journals in the United States. Dr. Mehta lectures both nationally and internationally.

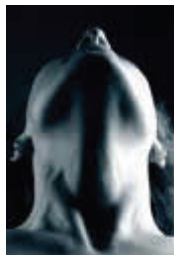
